Details: BoarsHead Theater would like to announce that on June 28th and June 29th, 2007, the Theater will hold its General Auditions for the 2007-2008 Season. Those interested in Auditions, both Equity and Non-Equity, should prepare the following:

- *Two contemporary and contrasting monologues.*
- *Both monologues should not exceed a total time of 3 minutes.*
- *You may sing, but singing is not required. Singing must be acapella, or with your own recorded CD. The theater will have a CD player on-hand for auditions.*
